

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

On receipt of the completed application form and fee, the Principal will place your daughter's name on the Application List. Parents and caregivers can then be kept informed about the school by way of newsletters and direct communication.

Applications for admission should be made as early as possible to ensure that your daughter has a reasonable chance of being offered a place.

At the beginning of the year prior to entry date, parents will be contacted regarding an interview with the Principal. All applicants are interviewed and offers of places are made in writing after these interviews. If your daughter is offered a place at Nga Tawa, acceptance of this offer must be made in writing and accompanied by a \$1,000.00 (non-refundable) Enrolment Fee for boarding or \$500.00 for Local boarding.

Fees

Fees are divided into ten payments over the year and are payable by the 20th of the month following invoice.
