- A covering letter stating the Scholarship(s) you are applying for
- A completed Scholarships checklist form
- Financial disclosure form if required
- Your daughter's Nga Tawa Diocesan School application form

Your covering letter should succinctly describe your daughter's interests, activities and achievements in relation to the scholarship you are seeking.

NGA TAWA DIOCESAN SCHOOL SENIOR SPORT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Nga Tawa Diocesan Board is offering a limited number of Sport Scholarships to prospective students entering year 11 and year 12 in 2025. These are full fee scholarships.

A Senior Sport Scholarship will be awarded to a student entering either year 11 or year 12 in 2025 that demonstrates outstanding skills, commitment and potential to excel in one or more of the major sporting codes played at Nga Tawa Diocesan School, which are:

- Athletics/Cross Country
- Cricket
- Hockey
- Netball
- Tennis

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must have completed an application form for Nga Tawa Diocesan School
- Only new students in 2025 are eligible for this scholarship
- The scholarship applicant must be a regional representative in their chosen sport to be considered and maintain their representative status whilst a student at Nga Tawa Diocesan School
- Recipients must display our values of Respect, Integrity and Courage at all times
- The sport you are awarded a scholarship for is the sport you must play at Nga Tawa Diocesan School
- Please be aware the Nga Tawa Diocesan School Director of Sport may also watch the applicant's performance prior to interview stage
- The recipient must make herself available to all Nga Tawa Diocesan School matches and practices in her chosen sport
- The decision of an applicant's success is the prerogative of the school
- Scholarships are subject to a termly review in both sport and academic outcomes

- Shortlisted students will be required to attend an interview with the Principal and Director of Sport at Nga Tawa Diocesan School in November 2024.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced by Friday 25 October 2024.
