

Proposed Enrolment Scheme

Kia ora koutou

Te Tāhuhu o te Mātauranga | The Ministry of Education, are currently working with the board of Nga Tawa Diocesan School to formalise an enrolment scheme for our school under Section 72 of the Education and Training Act 2020. An enrolment scheme is required as we currently receive more applications for day-girl places than are available. As a state integrated school, Nga Tawa Diocesan School has a maximum roll that determines the number of day student places available - the maximum roll for day girls is currently set at **40**.

For our school the enrolment scheme is essentially a formalising of the internal enrolment policy currently operated by the school. It is anticipated an enrolment scheme will be in place part-way through Term 1 2025 to assist in processing applications for the 2026 school year. **Note: there are no changes to the applications already approved for 2025**.

As part of this process, we are now inviting public submissions from the wider community on the proposed scheme. A copy of the scheme can be viewed on the Ministry of Education consultation website, or via the school website or office.
